Nigel has served faithfully for 12 years and he will be greatly missed by both staff and students. Following this, the new students were introduced and Dr Sarah Dalrymple prayed for them. Two students, Mark Rooney and Elizabeth Roberts, were interviewed by Dr Peter Firth about their first couple of weeks at IBC. Mr David Ellison was appointed as the new Training Director and he confirmed the call of God on his life to serve in this way. David promised to fulfil his charge with 'all faithfulness, to remain faithful to the word of God in Scripture, to lead by example and encourage dependence on the Holy Spirit'. He also promised to be 'faithful in prayer, constant in study, diligent in administration and supportive of [his] colleagues in the work to which God has called [him]'.
